The Ripley-Ohio-Dearborn (ROD) Special Education Cooperative has an opening for a part-time Special Education Teacher to serve as an Itinerant teacher to Nonpublic schools. This part-time position is for 2 days per week during the school year. The Itinerant Teacher will work with students and staff at the nonpublic schools of St. John, St. Mary, and St. Lawrence. The Itinerant Teacher consults and interacts with school administrators, teachers, and parents on academic remediation as well as provides direct intervention to elementary and middle school aged students with disabilities.

ROD is a special education cooperative that provides special education and related services in six school districts which are comprised of the Community School Districts of Jac-Cen-Del, Milan, South Ripley, Rising Sun-Ohio County, Lawrenceburg, and South Dearborn.

Responsibilities:

- Provide consultation to nonpublic schools, teachers, and parents with regard to special education program.
- Deliver specially designed instruction to individuals and small groups of identified students in nonpublic school settings.
- Carry out other responsibilities as assigned and as outlined in the Educational Consultant job description.

Job Qualifications:

- License as a teacher of students with disabilities
- Three to five years teaching experience at a minimum

Salary and Benefits:

- The salary and benefits as set by the current collective bargaining agreement
- Part-time two days per week
- Mileage is reimbursed at the federal rate.
