RE: Transfer of Parent Rights to students when they reach eighteen (18) years of age.

Dear student and parent,

This letter is to inform you that pursuant to Indiana Special Education Rules (511 IAC 7-43-5), upon reaching eighteen years of age, the parent rights outlined in Indiana Special Education Rules will transfer to the student unless a guardian (in accordance with IC 29-3) or an educational representative (in accordance with 511 IAC 7-43-6) has been appointed for the student. After the transfer of rights to the student have been made, the parents will continue to receive copies of all required special education notices; however, the student will make final decisions regarding his or her individualized education program (IEP).
