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## Employment Opening

Position: Educational Consultant / Teacher for Visually Impaired

Date Posted: March 31, 2023 - Date Closed: Open until filled - Start Date: August 2023

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The Ripley-Ohio-Dearborn (ROD) Special Education Cooperative has an opening for a full-time special educator to serve as an Educational Consultant and Teacher for Visually Impaired Students. The ideal candidate will be an experienced special education teacher who is either licensed to teach students with visual impairments or who is willing to obtain licensure as a condition of employment. For example, teachers can add Visual Impairment to their license through a 16 credit-hour online program through Indiana State University which the teacher could enroll in after hiring in at ROD. When not supporting students with visual impairments, the special educator will serve as an Educational Consultant, providing consultation to schools and conducting academic achievement assessments as a member of the Multidisciplinary Evaluation team.

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### Responsibilities:

- Provide consultation to schools, teachers, and parents with regard to special education program.
  - Serve as Teacher of Record for students with Visual Impairments.
  - Administer and complete all components of the educational portion of evaluations.
  - Prepare a comprehensive report with synthesis of all of the information obtained through the evaluation.
  - Carry out additional duties related as outlined in the Educational Consultant and Blind-Low Vision Teacher job descriptions.
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### Job Qualifications:

- License as a teacher of students with disabilities
  - Three to five years teaching experience at a minimum
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### Salary and Benefits:

- The salary and benefits as set by the current collective bargaining agreement
  - Mileage is reimbursed at the federal rate.
