Position: **Occupational Therapist**

The Ripley-Ohio-Dearborn (ROD) Special Education Cooperative has an opening for a full-time school-based Occupational Therapist.

ROD is an inter-local special education cooperative that provides special education and related services in eight school districts which are comprised of the Community School Districts of Jac-Cen-Del, Milan, South Ripley, Rising Sun-Ohio County, Lawrenceburg, and South Dearborn. The occupational therapist will work in selected districts within the co-op.

Responsibilities:

- Evaluate students for developmental levels, fine motor functioning, and self-care skills to assess their eligibility for school-based occupational therapy.
 - Develop IEP goals, implement those goals, monitor student progress, and change programming as necessary for students to achieve goals
 - Participate in case conferences as a committee member
 - Supervise Certified Occupational Therapy Assistants
 - Maintain a record of student services with appropriate documentation
 - Other responsibilities as assigned and as defined in the job description
 - Work as part of an interdisciplinary team to maximize positive outcomes for students with disabilities

 - Ability to perform physical movements associated with providing occupational therapy with students (e.g., bending, light lifting, stretching, etc.)
